It's a tradition at Ascension that the last Friday of the month is a "standing non-uniform day" for scholars (and staff) who wear Ascension spirit wear on those days. School is not always in session on the last Friday of the month, so the spirit wear non-uniform days are listed to avoid any confusion: 10/30/19 (**NO COSTUMES**), 11/20/19, 12/18/19, 1/28/20, 2/26/20, 3/26/20, 4/30/20, and 5/28/20.

Non-uniform day dress code: Please have your scholar(s) abide by the following dress code guidelines if they're participating online in distance learning or whenever we have an Ascension non-uniform day, including Ascension spirit wear days: scholars should wear long (to the knee) shorts or pants, athletic/dress shoes, and socks. **Do not wear...** hats, sandals, shirts without sleeves, leggings/jeggings, short shorts, short tops, and short skirts. Stomachs, backs, and shoulders must be covered. Thank you!

Things To Know: Only K-2 scholars have the option to attend Ascension in-person at this time; **There is currently NO** school bus transportation available to or from school, all K-2 scholars attending Ascension in-person must be transported to and from school by the scholar's family.
