WHAT

SLAM is an academic program. We provide a safe, caring, learning environment that combines core academic programs with enrichment and experiential learning. Scholars range in age from kindergarten through 8th grade, and each group is assigned a color. Scholars wear their class colors each day.

WHEN

SLAM is a six-week program, 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. beginning on Monday, June 17, and ending on Friday, July 26. Classes will not be held June 19 and July 4-5. Scholars are expected to attend every day, so please plan accordingly. Prepare to commit to all six weeks.

WHERE

Ascension School, 1726 Dupont Ave. N, Minneapolis, 55411. Extended-day programs are at Ascension, St. John Paul II, St. Pascal Regional and St. Peter Claver.

WHO

SLAM is open to scholars who are entering kindergarten through 8th grade and who attend an Ascension Catholic Academy school: St. John Paul II, St. Peter Claver, St. Pascal Regional or Ascension.

TRANSPORATION

Transportation is provided for North Minneapolis residents. We will notify you if your pick-up or drop-off address is outside our busing range.

We also offer transportation to and from St. John Paul II, St. Peter Claver and St. Pascal Regional with extended day care available at each school until 5 p.m.

You will be notified of pick-up and drop off times when the routes are finalized.







EXTENDED DAY

Families who need care until 5 p.m. must register for the extended day program. Each Academy school will offer extended day care at its own building. Families are responsible for picking up scholars on time; late fees will be assessed for pick-ups after 5 p.m.
